Introduction

The following describes Longeviti Neuro Solutions 's privacy practices, including its policy for information received from or about you during visits to the website. The amount and type of information received depends on how you use the website.

a. Personal Information

During normal website usage, we do not collect or store information that will directly identify you (such as name, mailing address, e-mail address or phone number). - to any competent law enforcement body, regulatory, government agency, court or other third party where we believe disclosure is necessary (i) as a matter of applicable law or regulation, (ii) to exercise, establish or defend our legal rights, or (iii) to protect your vital interests or those of any other person;
- Longeviti Neuro Solutions may transfer any information it has about you in the event it sells or transfers all or a portion of its business or assets or in the process leading up to an intended sale or transfer.
- to any other person with your consent to the disclosure.

d. Does Longeviti Neuro Solutions ever communicate directly with visitors to this website?

e. Cookies

f. How does Longeviti Neuro Solutions keep my personal information secure?

We use appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect the personal information that we collect and process about you. The measures we use are designed to

provide a level of security appropriate to the risk of processing your personal information. On Longeviti Neuro Solutions .com, we do not capture personal information except when a visitor chooses to submit personal information to request additional information or updates about the company.
